(The bag was like a computer bag and contained personal contained personal items including her keys.) The passenger jumped back onto the truck and turned on Commonwealth. Sometime between 7:00am and 4:30pm, but probably earlier than later since the neighbors we talked to were outside in the late morning and afternoon. Someone threw a brick through our kitchen window that looks out onto the alley and crawled through. A two-person job since the window is at least 6-feet off the ground. They were undeterred by our 90-pound german shepherd (they locked him in the basement). Didn't get terribly much: our 4 year-old MacBook, \$30 of loose change, some pocket knives, etc. The biggest loss, though not monetarily (I'm sure it wasn't worth terribly much), was an antique ruby engagement ring that was my great-grandmother's and that I proposed to Jodi with.
